EXCITING OPPORTUNITIES IN CLINTON AND LYCOMING COUNTIES

STEP AmeriCorps is currently recruiting members for the upcoming service year that begins August 23, 2019. AmeriCorps is the national service program that provides thousands of Americans of all ages and backgrounds with education awards in exchange for a year of community service. Full-time members who complete their service earn a Segal AmeriCorps Education Award of \$6,095.00 to pay for college, graduate school or vocational training at eligible institutions, or pay back qualified student loans. Or, if a member is at least 55 years of age at the beginning of the service term, he or she may transfer the award to a child, grandchild or foster child. AmeriCorps members receive a modest biweekly living allowance, student loan forbearance, health coverage, and child care for those who qualify while participating. Members who serve reduced full-time receive a living allowance and a \$4,266.50 education award and members who serve half-time receive a living allowance and a \$3,047.50 education award. AmeriCorps is not employment. Below is a current list of service positions available:
