In-Home Services

Help individuals to remain in their own homes as long as possible. Meals-on-Wheels, personal care, emergency response systems, home modifications, and light cleaning are just some of the services that may be available to you in your home. Even those who require Nursing Home level of care may be able to stay at home with our Aging Waiver program. If a long-term care facility is necessary, our agency is there to provide assessment and placement services.

Protective Services

The Older Adults Protective Services Act empowers the Office of Aging to investigate reports of abuse, neglect, financial exploitation, abandonment, or other situations that put an individual, or their finances, at imminent risk.
